

Local Leagues Lobbying the State Legislature

Wonderfully, several Local Leagues have groups that take action and lobby at the local level, using local, state, and/or national positions. If a Local League wants to lobby at the state level, they must contact the LWVCO Office, so that Local and State Leagues speak with one voice.

From the Policy portion of Policy 201.00 - Advocacy and Lobbying:

"The League (at all three levels) speaks with one voice. This demonstrates our unity and strengthens our impact on issues and our advocacy and lobbying efforts, in order to make a greater impact on issues....If the local League wants to interact with a state elected official, they must contact the LWVCO Office."
