The bill's provision that disallows a registered voter from serving on a county redistricting commission solely because they choose to affiliate with a minor party is prejudicial and unwarranted. The bill violates the principle of one person one vote in defining the composition of county redistricting commissions. Commissions would consist of 7 members with the majority (4 members) being affiliates of the two largest political parties. The provision of majority control to the two largest political parties is permanent and gives the two largest parties control of county districting forever, regardless of a county's political make-up. For example, the majority of voters in San Juan County are unaffiliated. How can it be justified that Democratic and Republican Party affiliates would have majority control of redistricting in a county with a majority of unaffiliated voters. The bill should be amended so that the composition of of county redistricting commissions is reflective of the political demographics of
